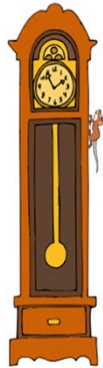

### Hickory Dickory Dock

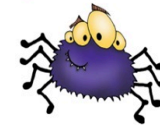
Hickory, dickory, dock.

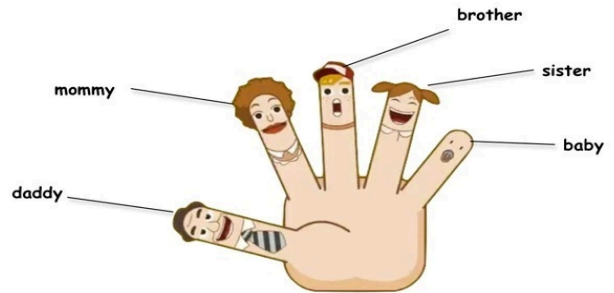
